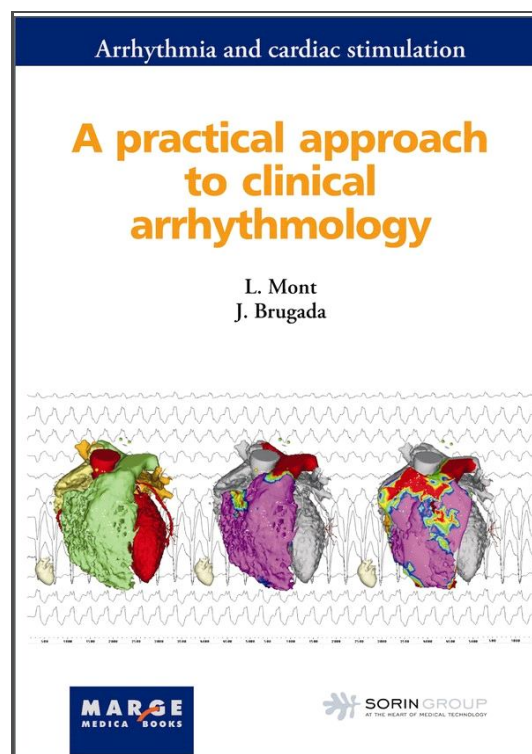


# A practical approach to clinical arrhythmology
